Christian Heritage Party Key Principles



1. CHP-BC is pro-life from conception until natural death.
2. We are pro-family. We support natural, traditional marriage between one man and one woman.
3. We support freedom of speech and freedom of religion.
4. We resist “judge-made law” (judicial activism). In a democracy, citizens must rule through their elected representatives, not be ruled by the courts.
5. We support the Charter preamble which states “Canada is founded on principles that recognise the supremacy of God and the rule of law”. This means that all citizens must be treated equally.
6. Public schools must not undermine parental authority. They must not promote immorality or inappropriate sexual behaviours. Parents, not the State, have primary responsibility for their children’s moral training and religious beliefs.
7. We believe in conscience legislation for doctors, nurses, teachers, commissioners of oaths and all citizens. No citizen should be forced to violate his or her conscience.
8. We believe governments should balance their budgets, not “cook their books”. BC can and should become truly debt-free.
9. We believe in responsible resource use, reduced waste and value-added exports, with an eye to protecting our God-given natural environment; we also believe we must nurture and protect our moral environment for our children.

CHP-BC Platform & Policies



1. Health Care—repeal Bill 36; put doctors and nurses back to work . . . with compensation for their unjust termination.
2. Education—restore parental rights and scholastic excellence
3. Justice—public safety and restitution to victims of crime
4. Jobs and Economy—responsible resource use
5. Taxes and Government Spending—eliminate waste and debt
6. Affordable Housing—end foreign purchase of BC homes
7. Democratic Reform—end “Alternative Approval”
8. Personal Freedom—speech / conscience / medical
9. Environment—natural and moral
10. Transportation and Access—roads, bridges, parking
11. Agriculture and Land Use—use it wisely!

Access to Health Care



1. Repeal the NDP's draconian Bill 36
 - a. End government overreach in medicine
 - b. Allow health professionals to govern their own colleges
2. Rehire and Compensate ALL Health Care Professionals Fired Due to COVID Mandates
 - a. Eliminate ALL vaccine mandates
 - b. Ensure conscience protection and free speech rights for all health care workers
3. Reduce patient wait-times:
 - a. Allow private delivery of publicly-funded care
 - b. Speed up approval process for foreign-trained doctors
 - c. Increase training spaces at medical schools
 - d. Additional shifts for MRIs, etc.
 - e. When BC cannot provide treatment in a timely fashion, help patients to get urgent treatment in other provinces or countries

Access to Health Care



4. Stop wasting taxpayer health \$ on non-health problems
 - a. Defund abortion, euthanasia, assisted suicide and “gender re-assignment” surgery.
5. End BC’s FAILED and UNSAFE injection sites
 - a. Close In-Site and other “needle exchange” sites
 - b. Provide supervised treatment for those suffering from addictions and mental illness—compassionate care for those who cannot care for themselves
 - c. Enforce existing laws against drug pushers
 - d. Abandon BC’s “soft on drugs” experiment and seek to reduce or eliminate fentanyl and opioid trafficking

Access to Health Care



6. Conscience Protection For Health Professionals
 - a. for doctors, nurses and ALL healthcare workers:
no citizen should be forced to violate his / her
conscience re. abortion, gender issues, euthanasia,
etc.
7. Improve access to much-needed palliative care
8. Better Hospital Design—more single-bed rooms and
better sanitation.

Education for Excellence



1. Parental Rights—recognize parents as first educators
2. Choice in Education—equal funding for students in public, private, charter and independent schools
3. End political indoctrination in BC public schools. Cut funding for “Out in Schools” gender propaganda
4. End bullying and peer pressure in regard to sexuality; eliminate FAILED and DESTRUCTIVE sex-ed focus
5. Focus instead on educational excellence; emphasize math, science, history, literature and writing skills
6. Make more trades training and certification available
7. Conscience Protection for teachers—no teacher should be forced to teach gender confusion or race-based curriculum

Justice



1. Public Safety
 - a. Dangerous offenders serve their time
 - b. Reduce court delays
2. Restitution for Property Crimes
 - a. Perpetrators held accountable
 - b. Victims made whole
 - c. Costs should be a deterrent to crime and repayment a way of becoming part of society
3. End “Revolving Door” of crime and incarceration
4. Give citizens Dignity and Purpose—offenders must learn to “do unto others” as unto themselves. . . the Golden Rule.

Jobs and Economy



1. Responsible Resource Development
2. BC to achieve economic success by responsibly stewarding what we have: natural gas, timber, fresh water, minerals, fish, tourism
3. Return to a “Day Labour” model for smaller infrastructure projects; employ local contractors and equipment operators wherever practical
4. Encourage “value-added” manufacturing over raw resource exports: timber, fish, water, minerals

Taxes and Spending



1. **NO CARBON TAX**
2. No “taxes on taxes”
3. End deficit spending; implement mandatory balanced budgets
4. Use “net debt” figures when reporting debt and deficits
5. Pipeline approvals should be linked with upgrading and refining facilities to keep jobs in BC and Canada
6. Donations to charitable organizations which feed the poor should be eligible for tax credits equal to those of political parties

Affordable Housing



1. Reduce taxes on new homes and home purchases—currently 37% of the cost of a new home is taxes. There are 107 different taxes and fees on housing in the Vancouver area
2. Instead of the 15% tax on non-resident purchases, restrict housing and farmland purchases to Canadian residents ONLY
3. Do not use taxpayer dollars to encourage higher mortgage debt loads
4. Eliminate BC Property Transfer Tax

Democratic Reform



1. Free votes in the legislature for all MLAs
2. End “Alternative Approval” (default approval) for local spending decisions
3. Use Section 33, the “Notwithstanding Clause” to protect BC citizens from arbitrary rulings of the courts
4. Introduce preferential balloting for provincial elections
5. Direct election of the Premier by voters
6. Improve Initiative and Recall legislation

Personal Freedom and Responsibility



1. Freedom of Speech—not political correctness
2. Informed Choice for all medical procedures
3. Parental Rights—not the State
4. End Drug-Enabling Injection Sites & Free Drugs
5. Conscience Protection for all citizens
6. Reduce red tape and restrictions for small business and home businesses
7. End BC government’s “gambling addiction” and the dependence on gaming for provincial revenues

Environment



1. Clean up raw sewage discharge
2. Reinstate BC's laws on Weather Modification. ZERO intentional discharge of particulates from aircraft. CHP-BC opposes "climate geoengineering"
3. Consumer choice—demand labelling of GMO seed and crops
4. Monitor pesticide and herbicide use and enforce overspray compliance to protect neighbouring crops
5. Make provision for horse-logging and selective logging; facilitate woodlot access

Transportation and Access

1. Allow private vehicle insurance to compete with ICBC for the mandatory \$200,000 3rd party liability insurance.
2. Free hospital parking for up to 2 hrs.
3. Reduce ferry fares for BC licence plates

Agriculture and Land Use



1. BC agricultural land should be owned by BC residents, not foreign corporations
2. End foreign purchase of BC farms and residences—make BC housing affordable again and encourage young farmers
3. Restrict industrial takeover of prime agricultural land. Encourage organic and specialty crops through training and market research
4. Work with the federal government and First Nations to resolve outstanding land claims and land use issues

BC has the potential!



1. BC must become life-affirming. Promote adoption, not abortion and compassionate palliative care over euthanasia
2. BC must become conscience-affirming. BC courts and legislature MUST protect the consciences of parents, teachers, doctors, nurses and lawmakers
3. BC must strive to become debt-free, drug-free and crime-free
4. BC young people must be given PURPOSE to become successful as students, workers and parents
